Risk factors for Torsades de Pointes		
Non-Modifiable	Possibly Modifiable	Drug-induced
Congenital long QT syndromes	Bradycardia (pulse < 50 b/m)	Anti-arrhythmics
Elderly (> 65 yo)	Electrolyte DOs (hypokal, hypomag, hypocal)	Antibiotics
Fam hx of sudden cardiac death (< 50 yo)	Eating disorders	Antidepressants
Female sex	Heart failure	Antipsychotics
History of arrhythmias	Hypoglycemia	Methadone
Myocardial infarction	Hypertension	
Structural brain disease	Hypothyroidism	
	Drug interactions that increase levels	
	Acute Hepatic Failure	
	Alcohol Use	
	Myocardial ischemia	

Guidance when combining agents

QT Prolongation Management	
ECG indicated? (See Algorithm)	
>440ms (men) or >460ms (women)?	No -> Continue therapy, Repeat EKG annually/dose change
Hypo-kalemia/magnesemia/calceemia?	Yes -> Correct
Medication induced?	No -> Consider Long QT Syndrome
>500ms or >60ms increase above baseline? Or *High Risk features? Or Syncope present?	No -> Change med or continue if indicated and continue monitoring EKGs
Admit to hospital Discontinue or reduce med	

Continuous Telemetry Treat arrhythmia if necessary	
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*High Risk features:
Torsades
Ventricular ectopy
T-wave Alternans
AV Block
Widened QRS

When to obtain EKG Algorithm	
IV Haldol or Pimozide	
Methadone $\geq 120\text{mg/day}$	
AP, TCA, Li, Methadone, Celexa, Stimulant	AND any of the following:
	Bradycardia
	Structural heart disease
	Cardiac arrhythmias
	Known prolonged QTc
	Hepatic Dysfunction
	Hx of Syncope
	Fam Hx of sudden unexplained deaths
	Fam Hx of congenital Long QT Syndrome
	On other QT prolongating drugs
	On P450 inhibitors
	Risk of Electrolyte abnormalities (eating disorder, diuretic, etc)
	Hypokalemia, hypomagnesemia, hypocalcemia
Concern for acute ingestion -> AMS, Delirium -> Acute cardiac symptoms ->	Acute Medical Eval which may include EKG
